


1 - SKILLS FOR LIFE

What we want:



To raise awareness and knowledge of life skills among young people.



Create of a Life Skills Charter for schools and youth clubs.

Create of a series of workshop resources to accompany the Charter.

What we'll achieve:

At least 25% of schools and youth clubs will sign up to the Charter.

Creation of at least 10 resources for schools and youth clubs to use.



What we want:



To understand young people's attitudes, experiences and views of hate crime.

What we'll do:

Plan and undertake a peer research project with local young people.

To share these stories, and findings from the research, through a final report and short film.

What we'll achieve:



1,000 young people give their views on hate crime in Greenwich.



Local decision-makers will receive the report and respond to its findings.

3 - YOUNG PEOPLE WHO ARE MIGRANTS OR REFUGEES

What we want:



To promote and share the experiences of people who are migrants or refugees.

What we'll do:

Host a series of cultural events to bring together different migrant communities.

To document the learning and stories through a short film.
