

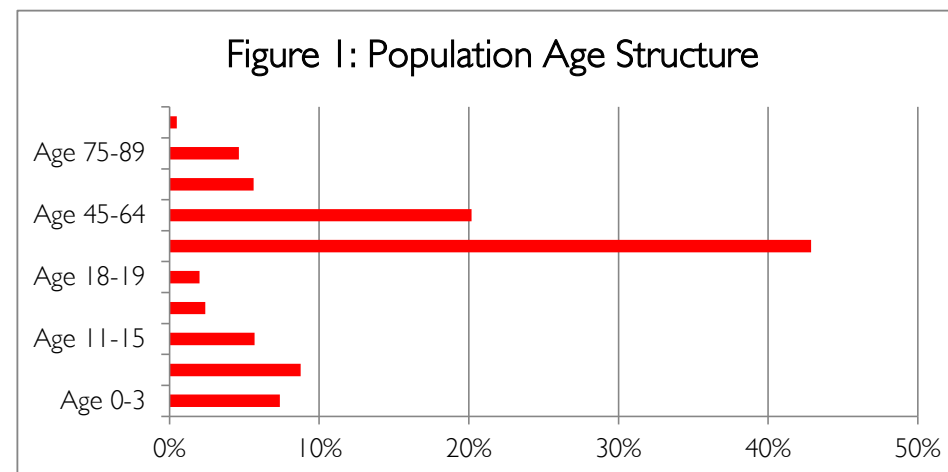

Figure I.2: Population Age Structure

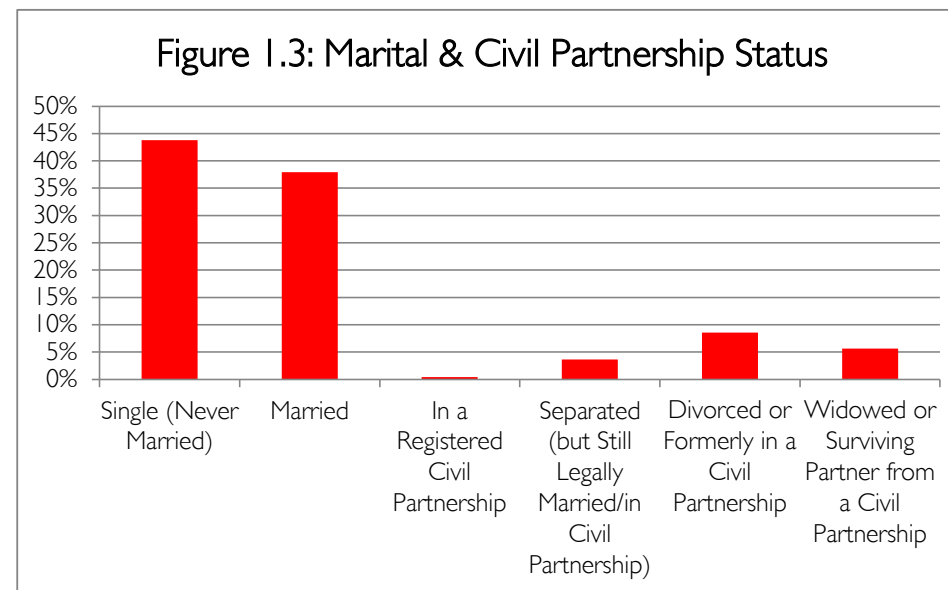

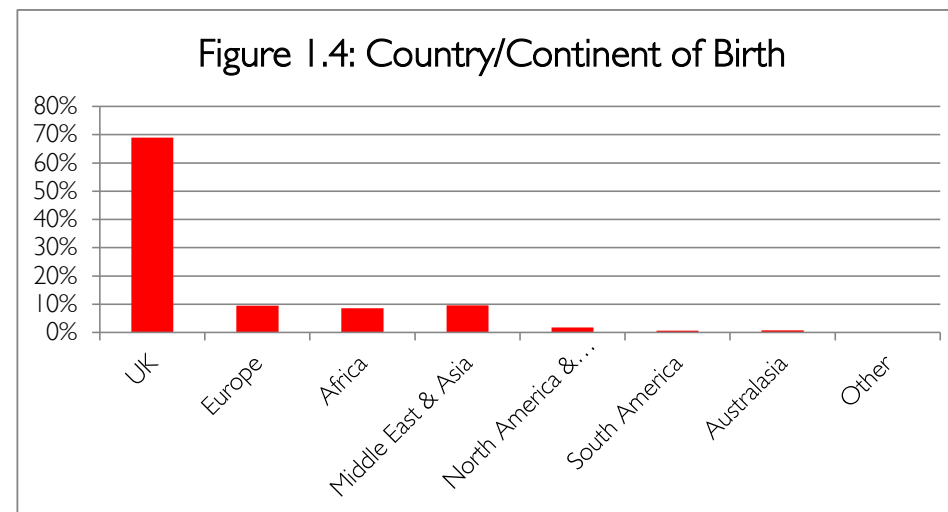

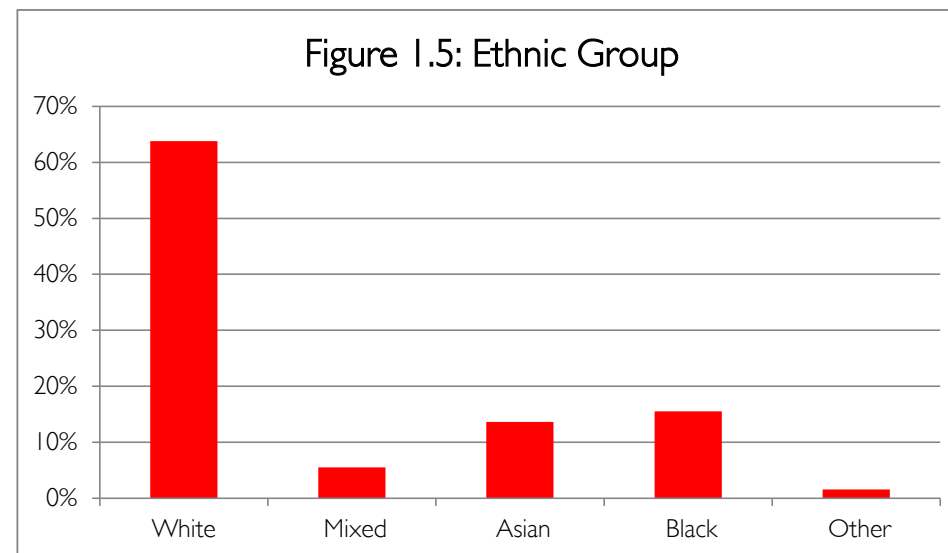

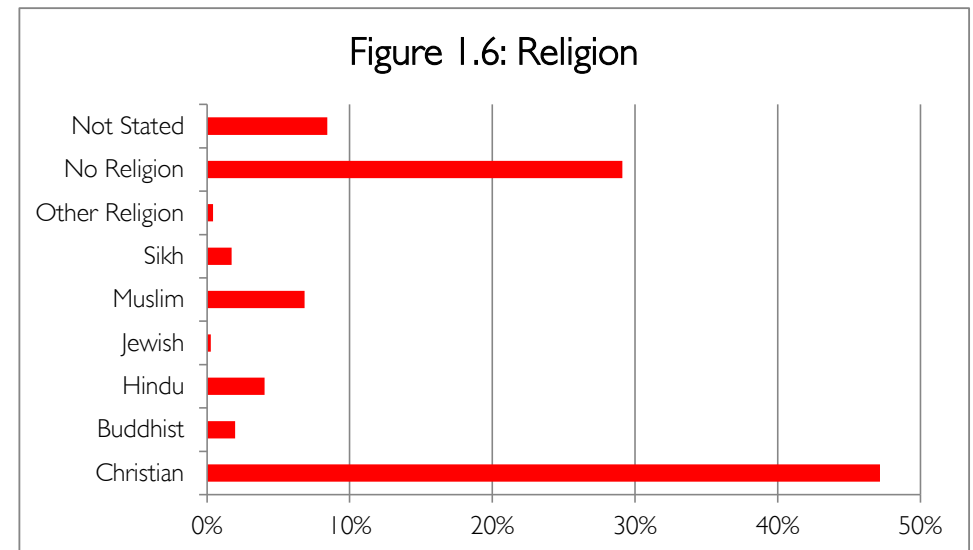

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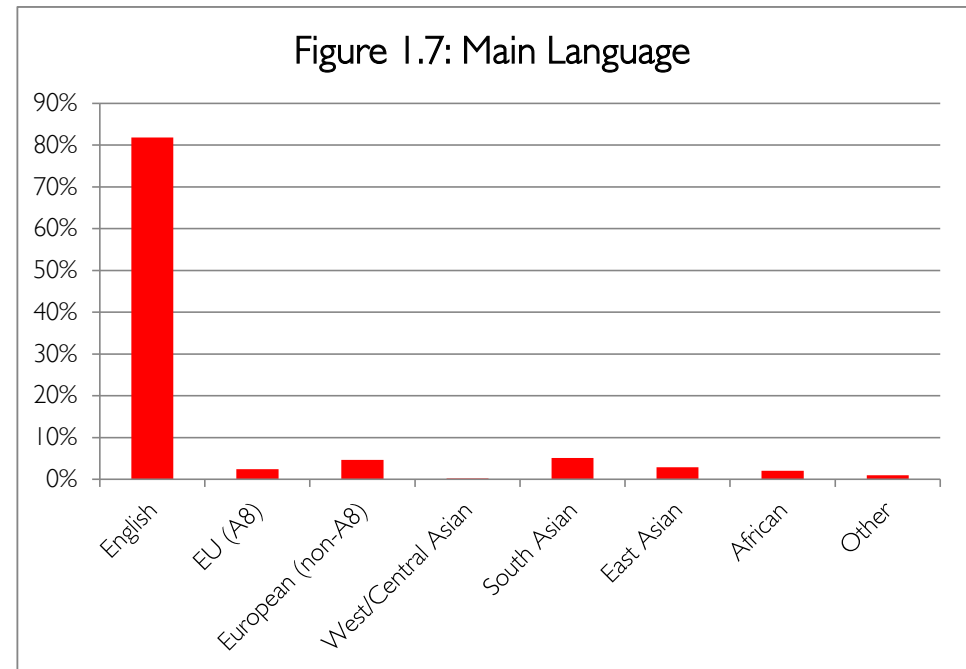

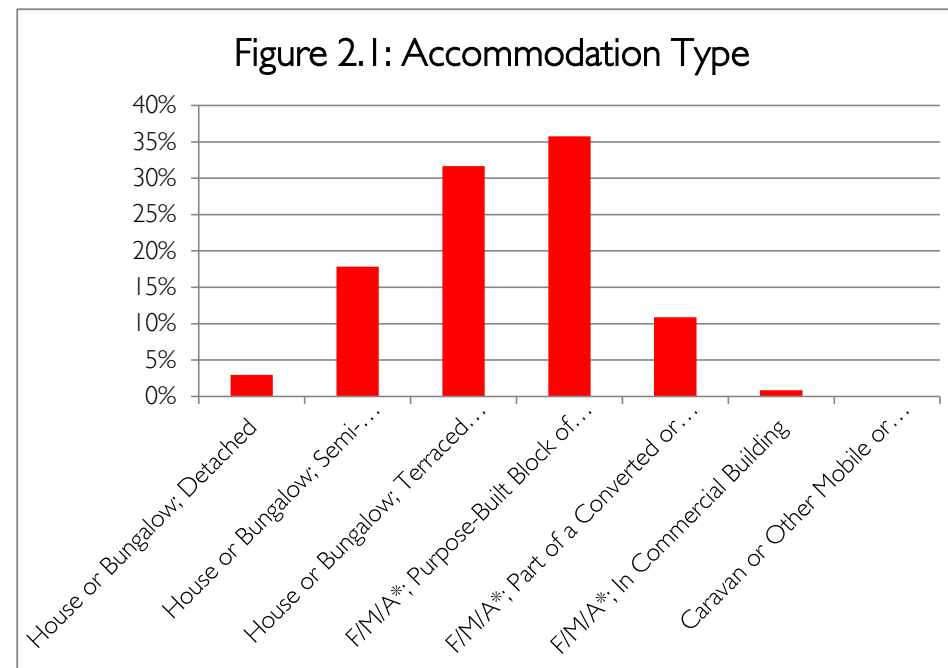

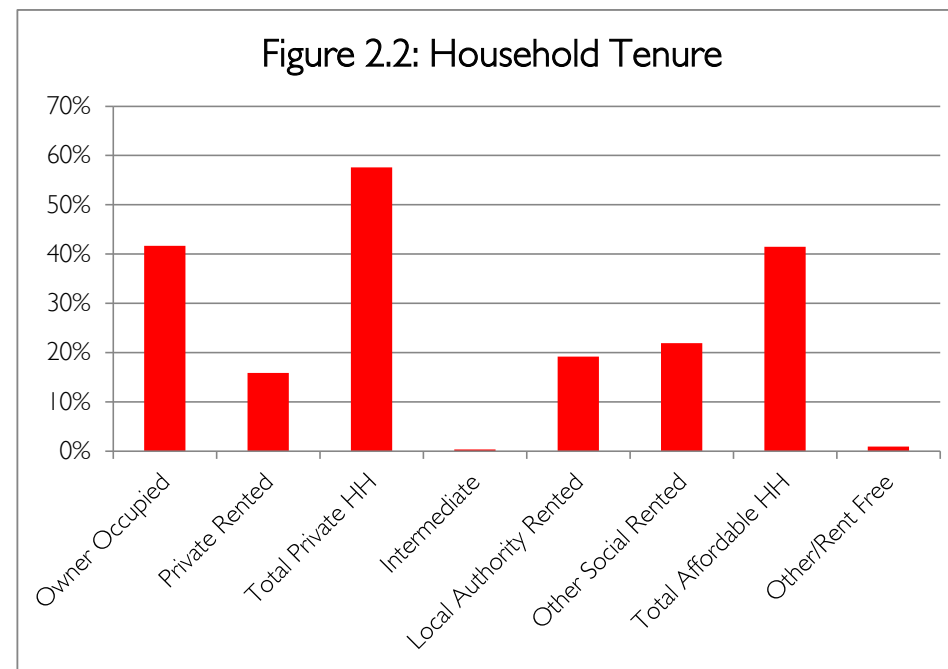

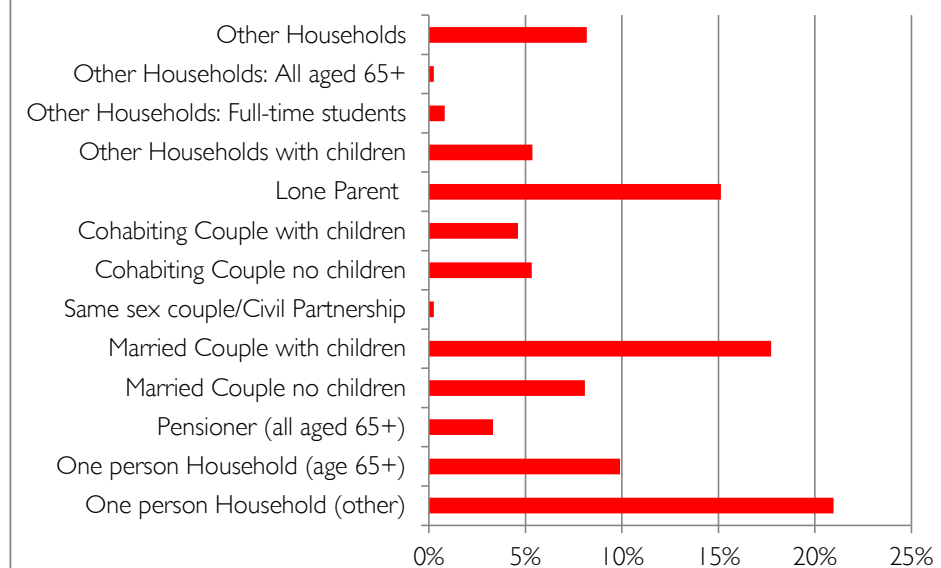

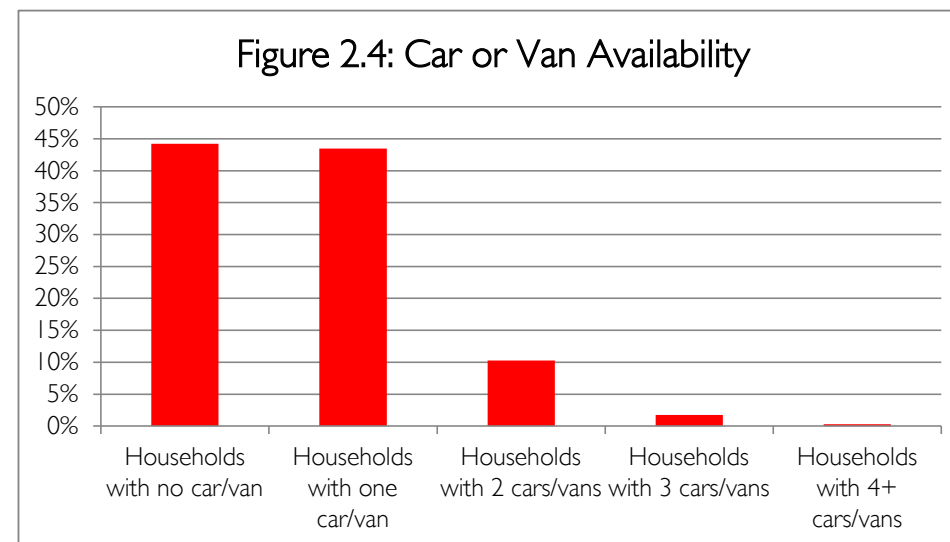

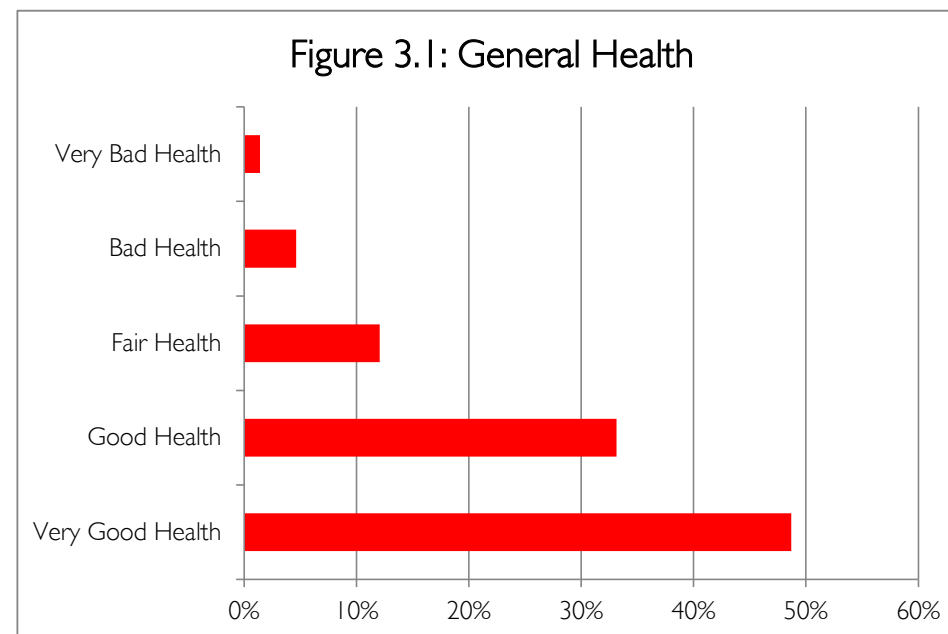

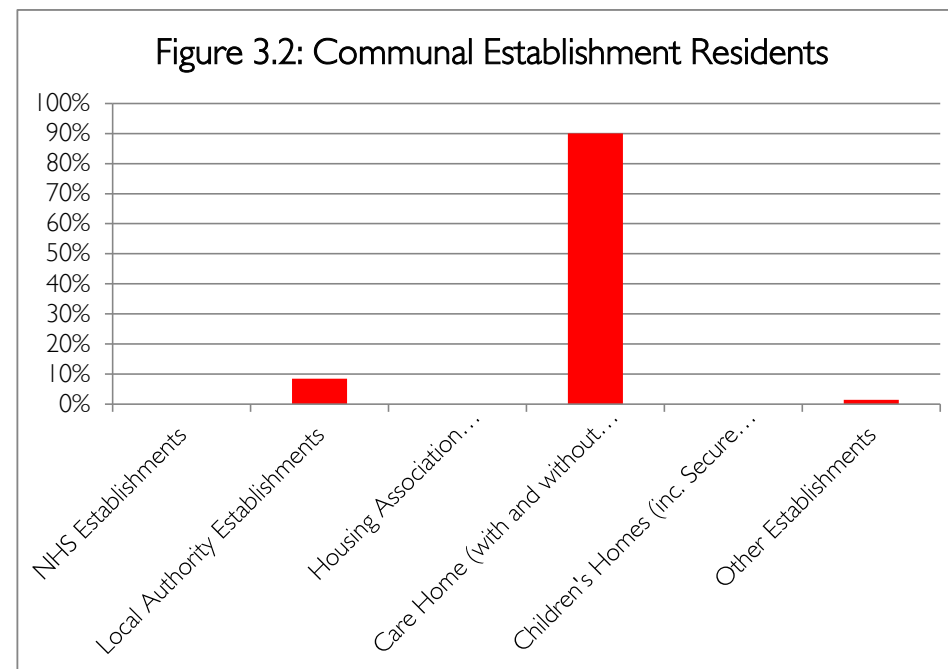

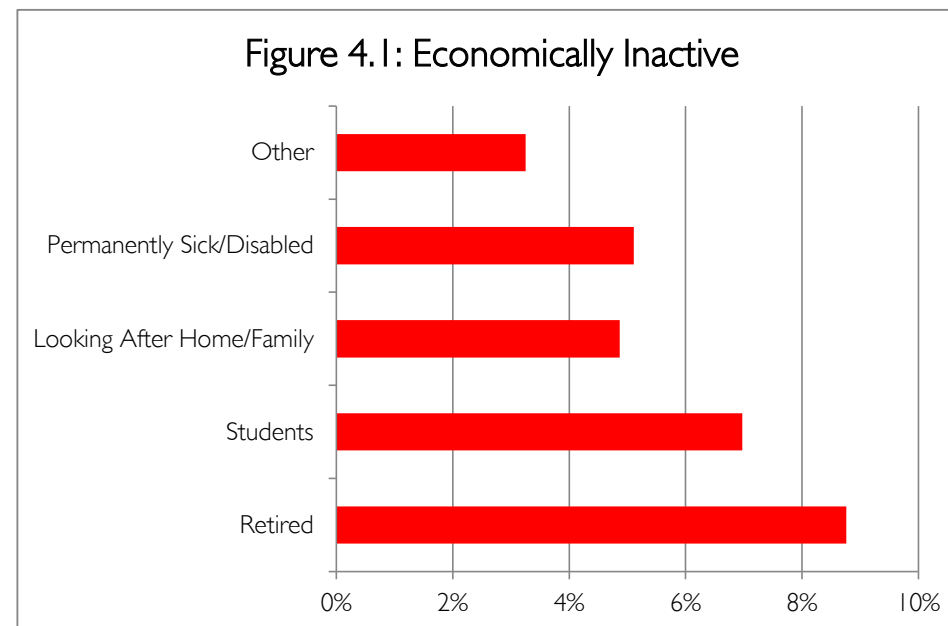

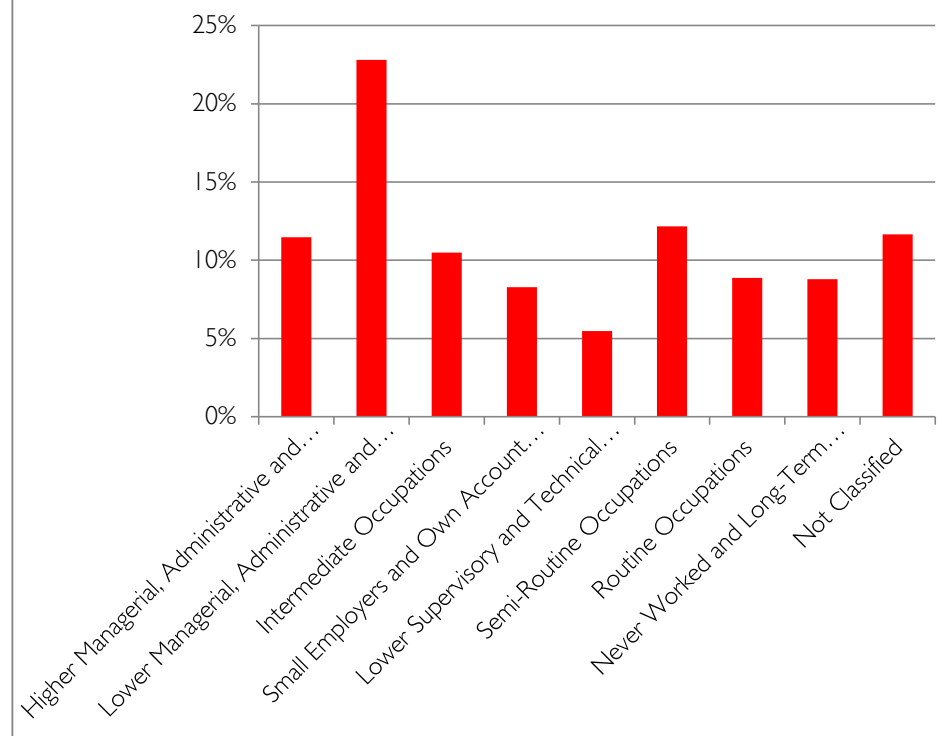

Figure 4.3: National Statistics Socio-Economic Classification



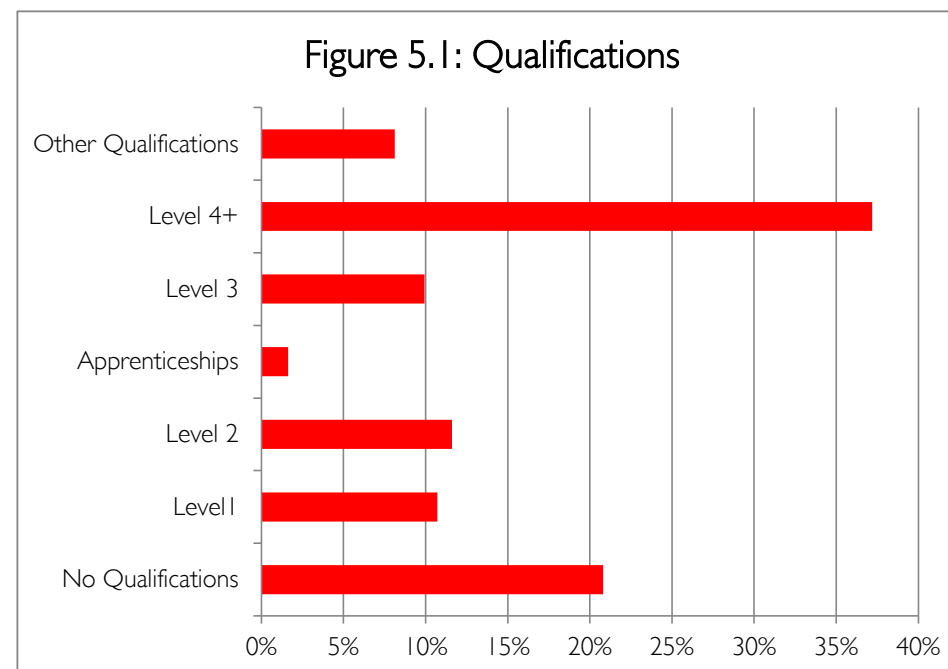

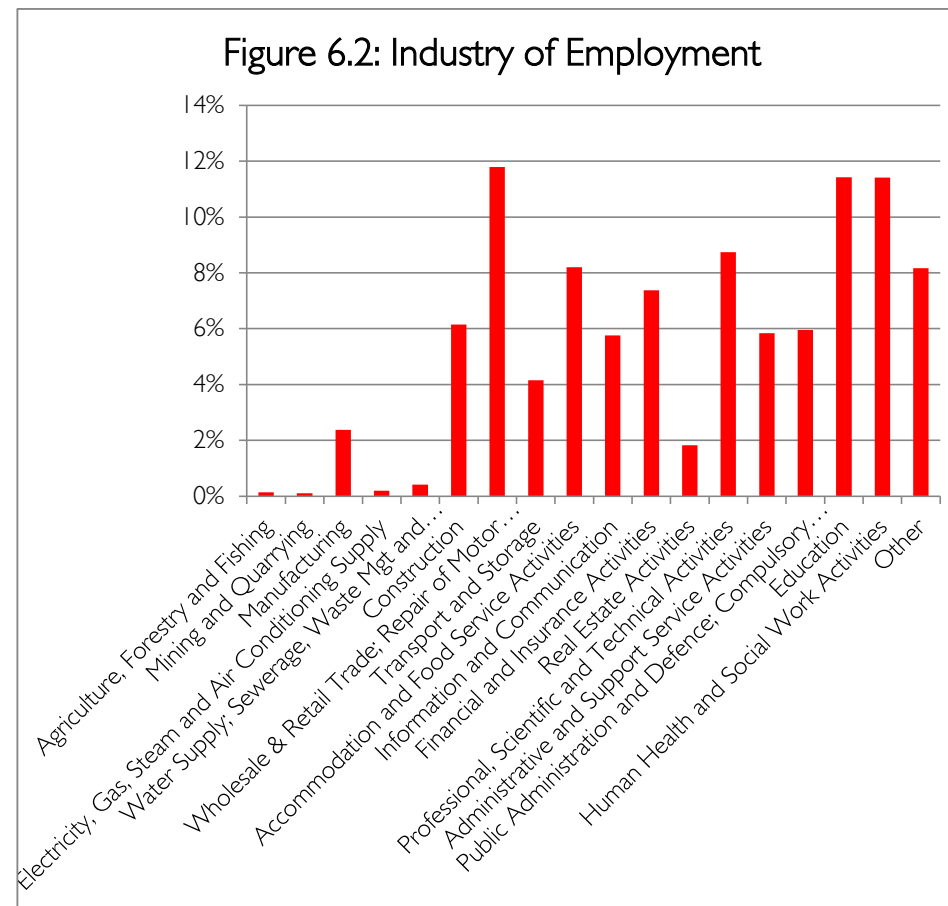

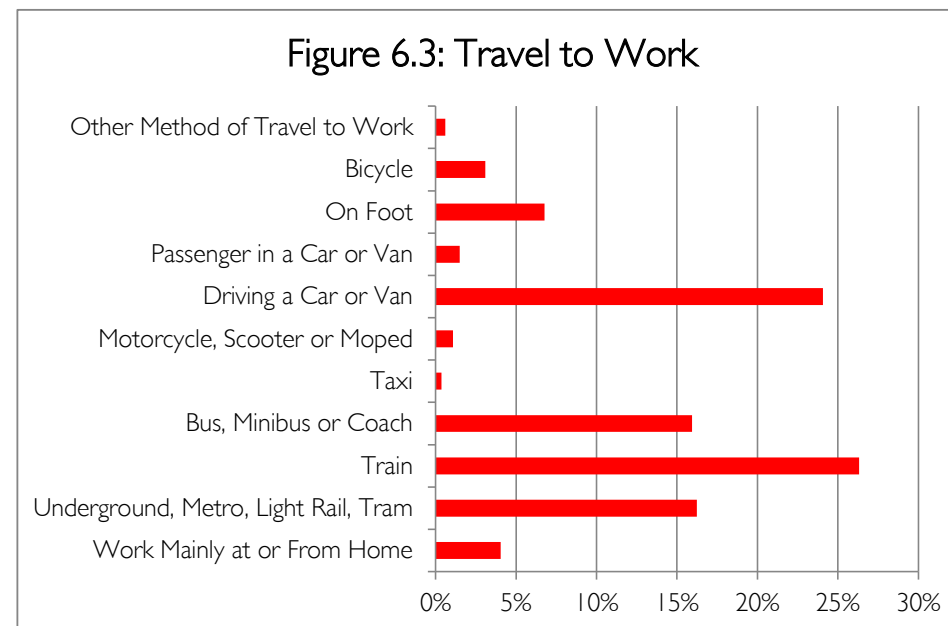
