

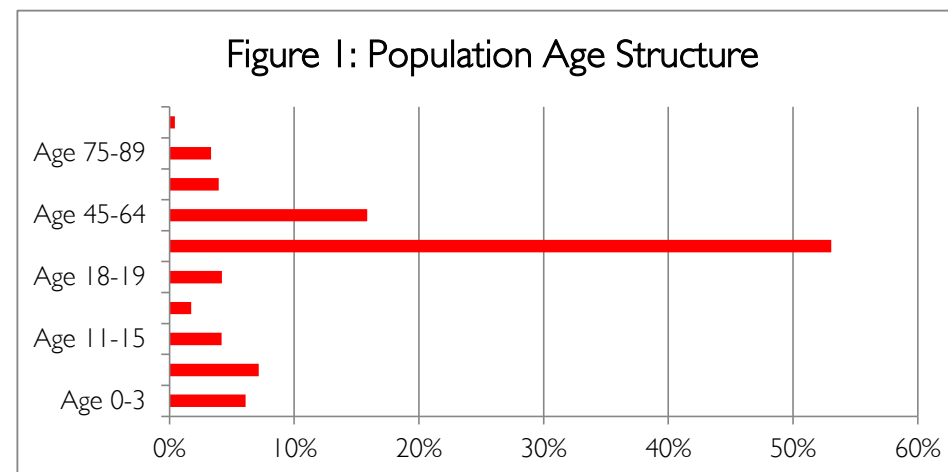

Figure I.2: Population Age Structure

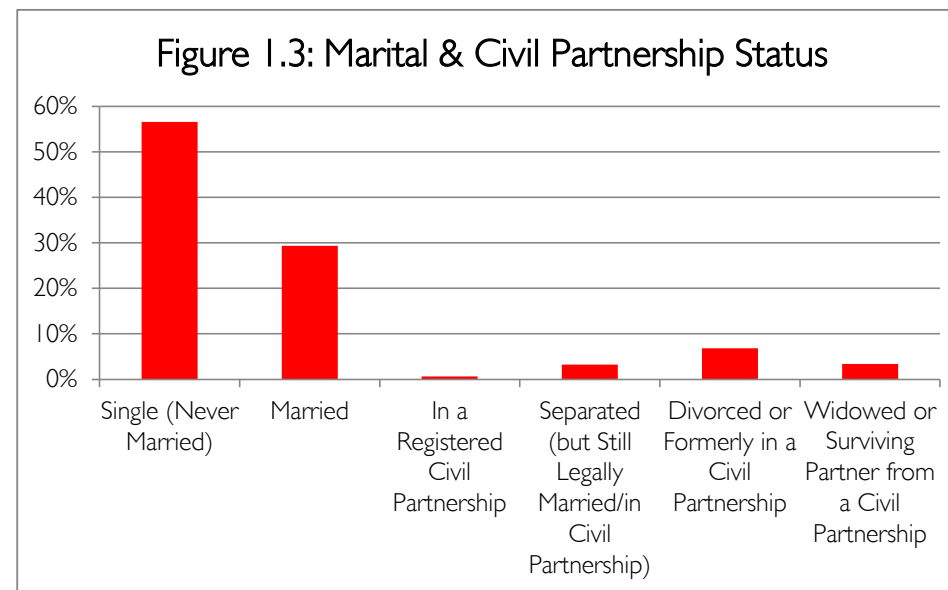

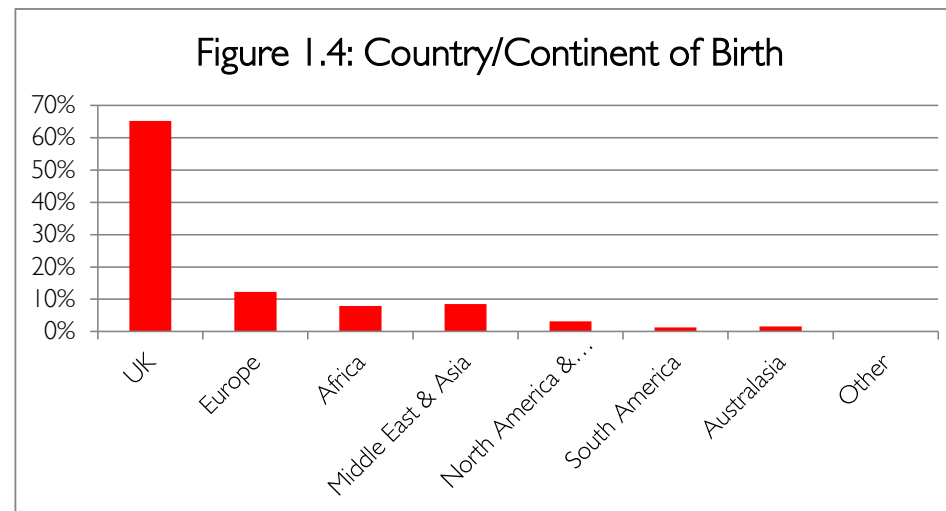

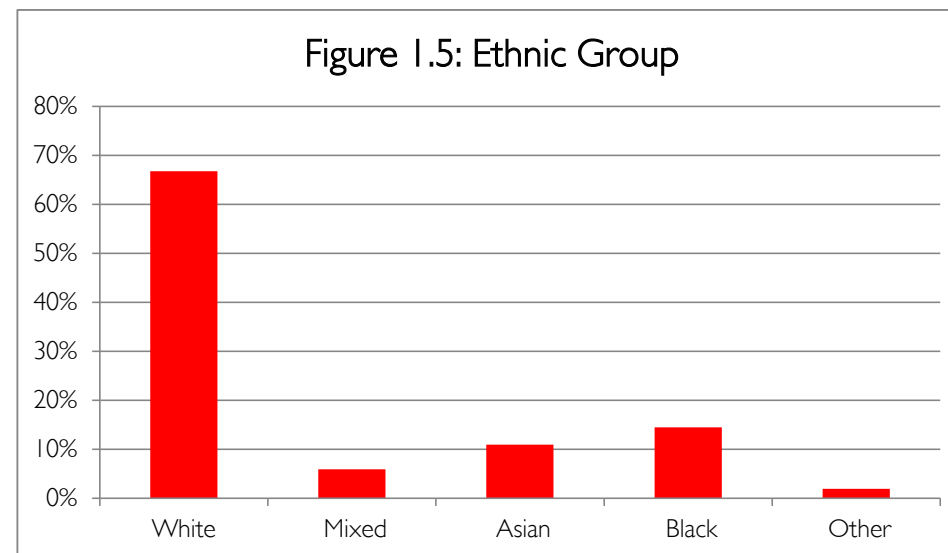

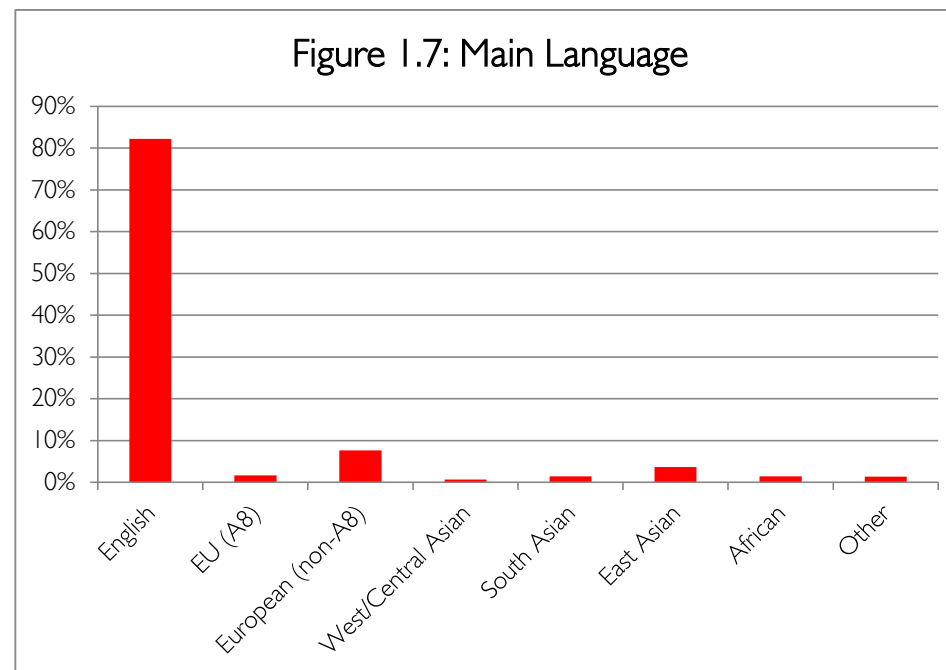

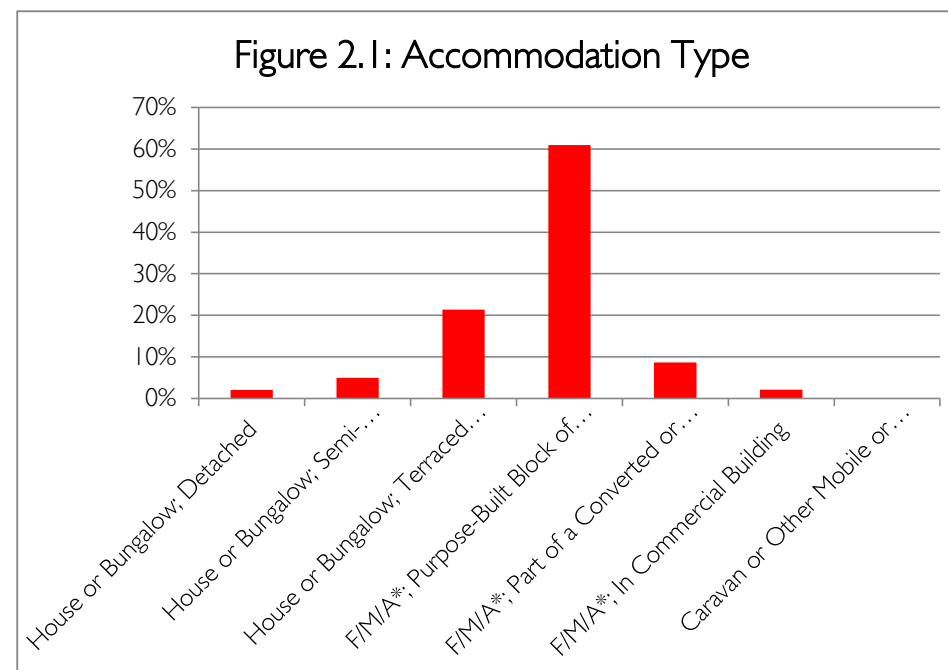

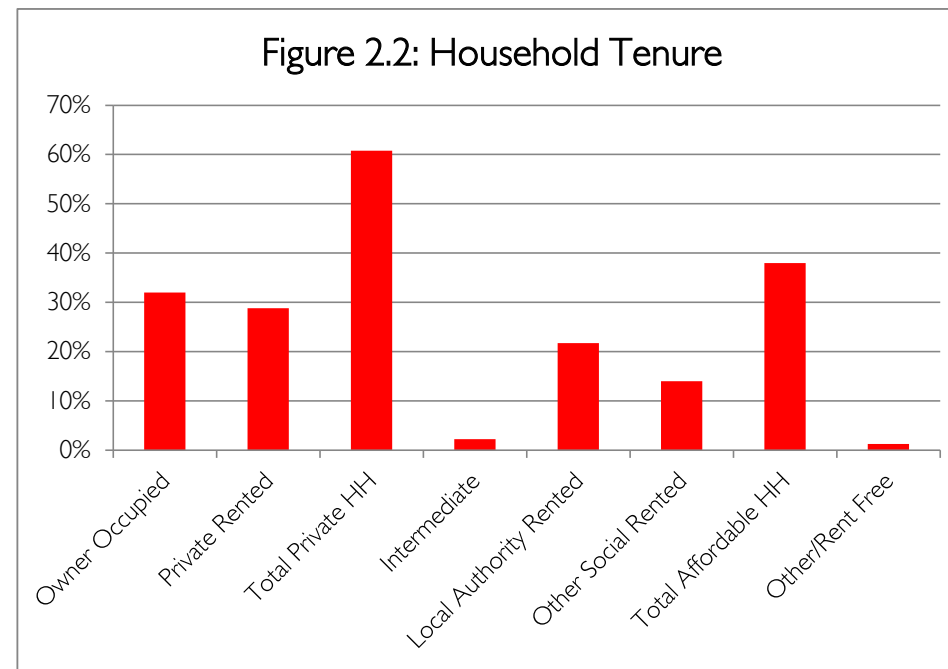

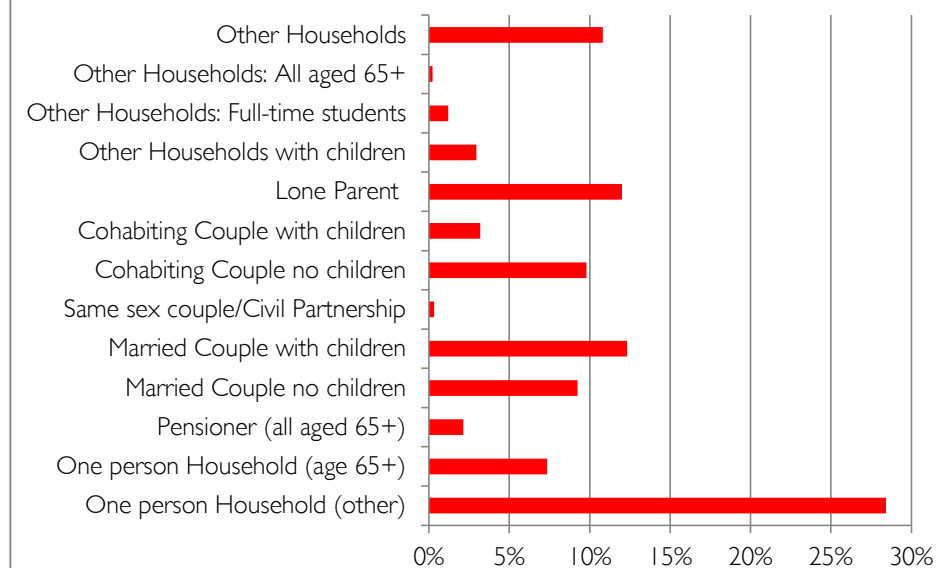

Figure 2.3: Household Composition



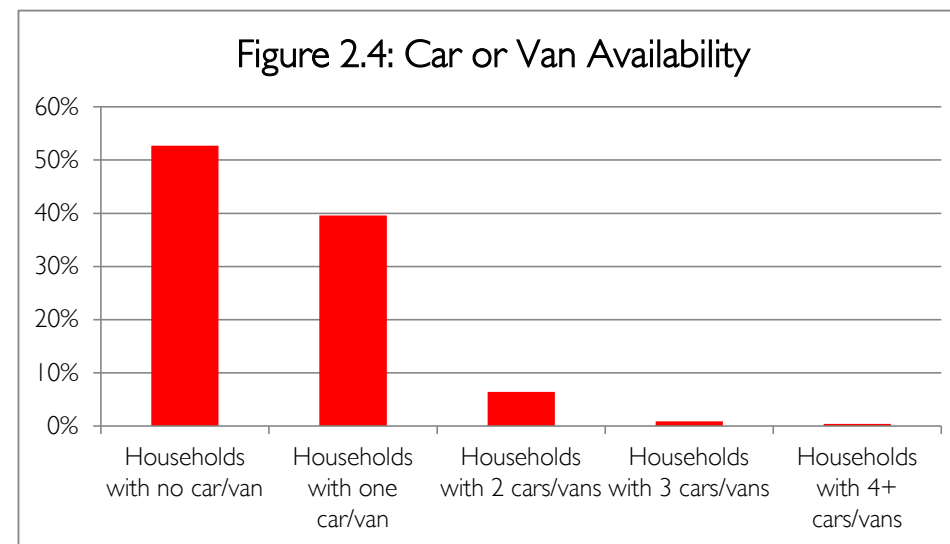

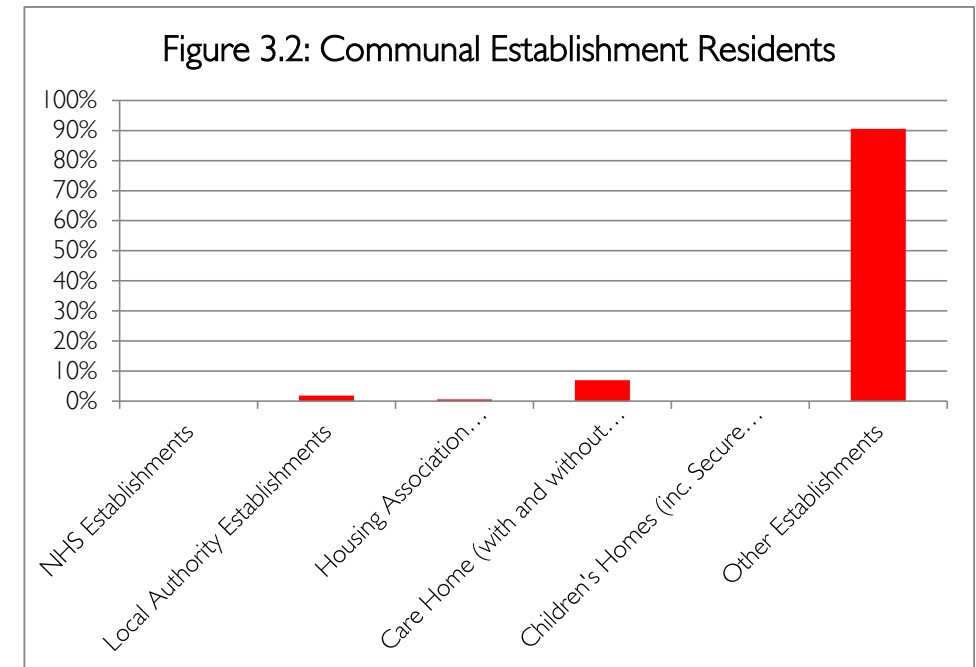

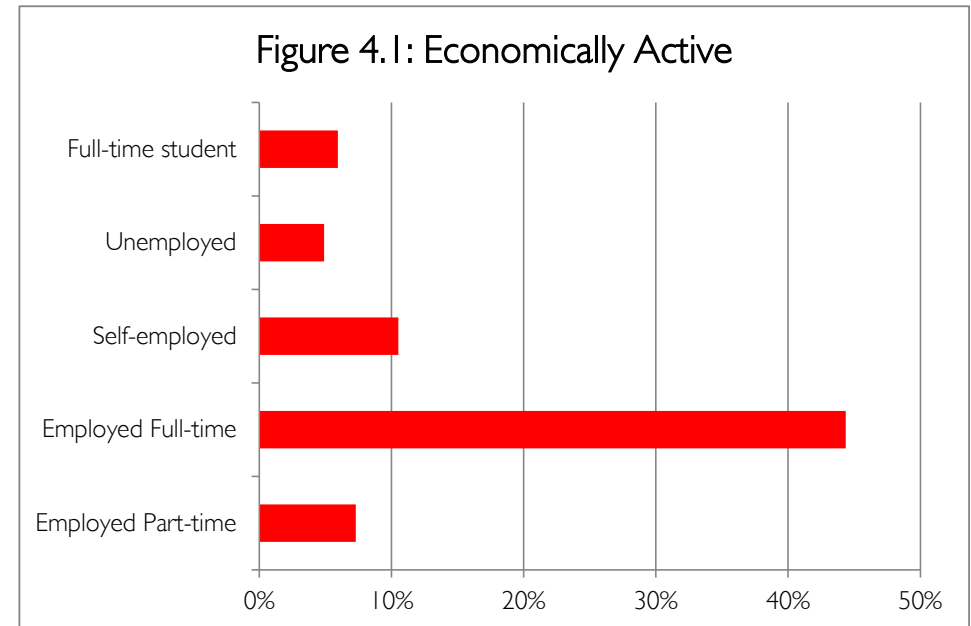

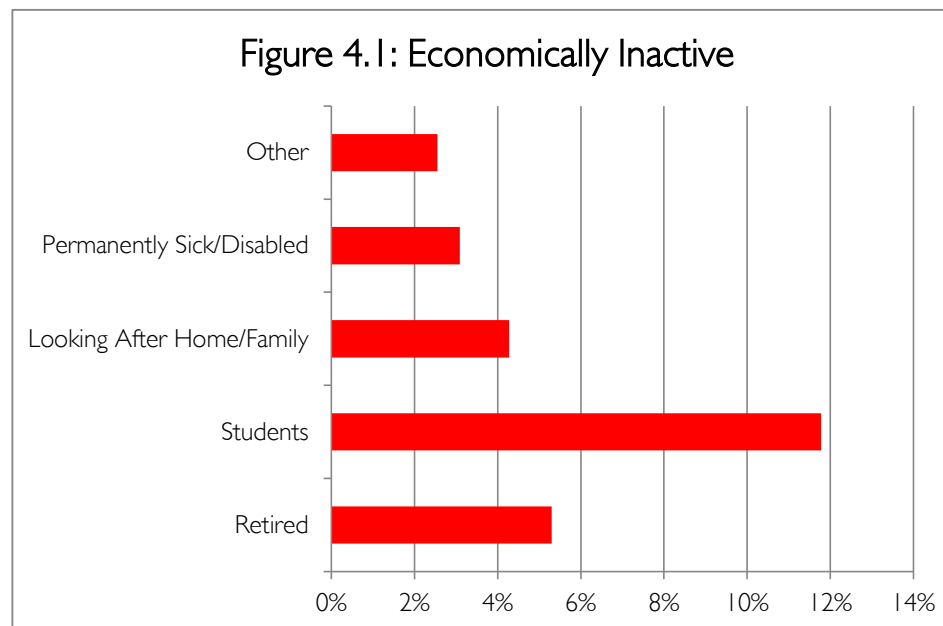

**Figure 4.1: Economically Inactive**

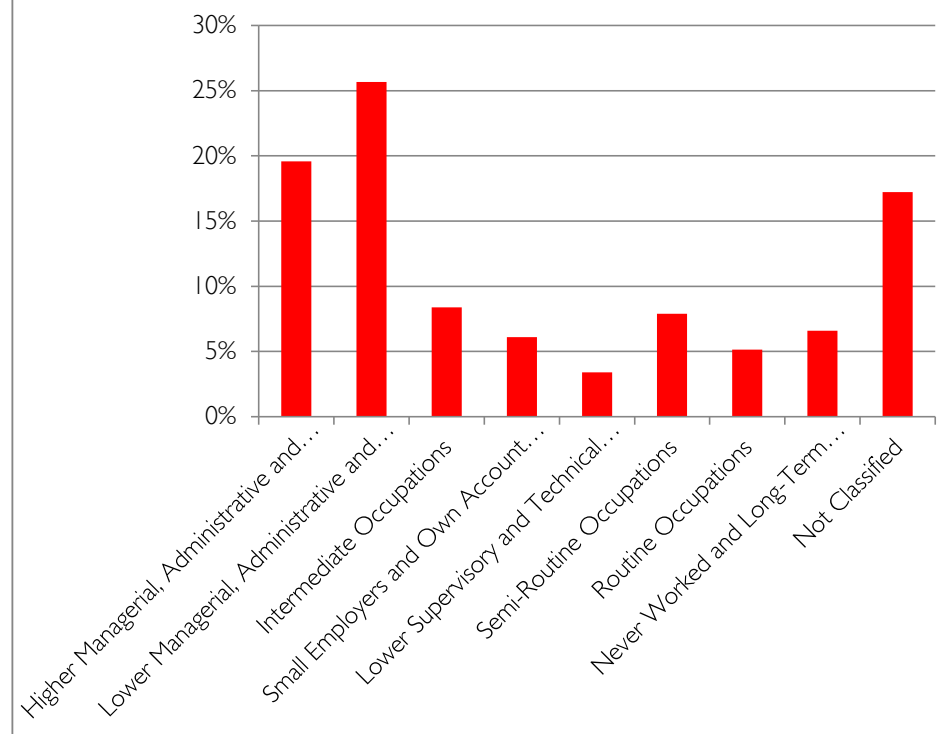

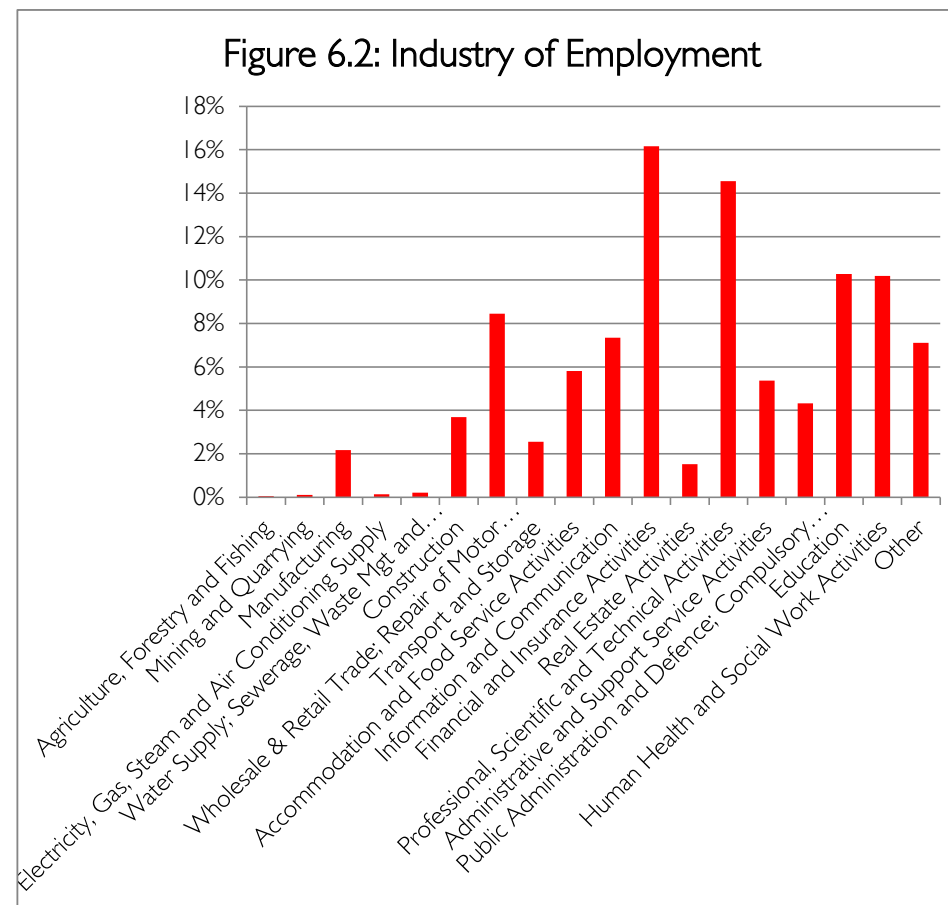
