

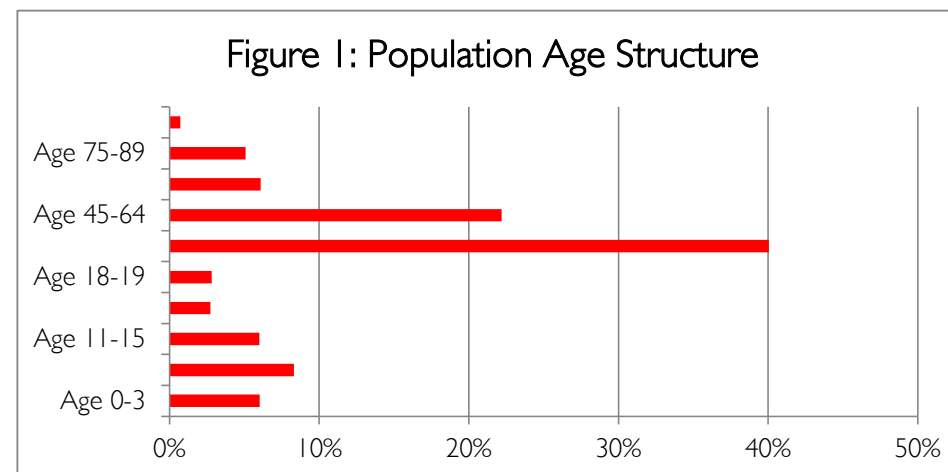

Figure I.2: Population Age Structure

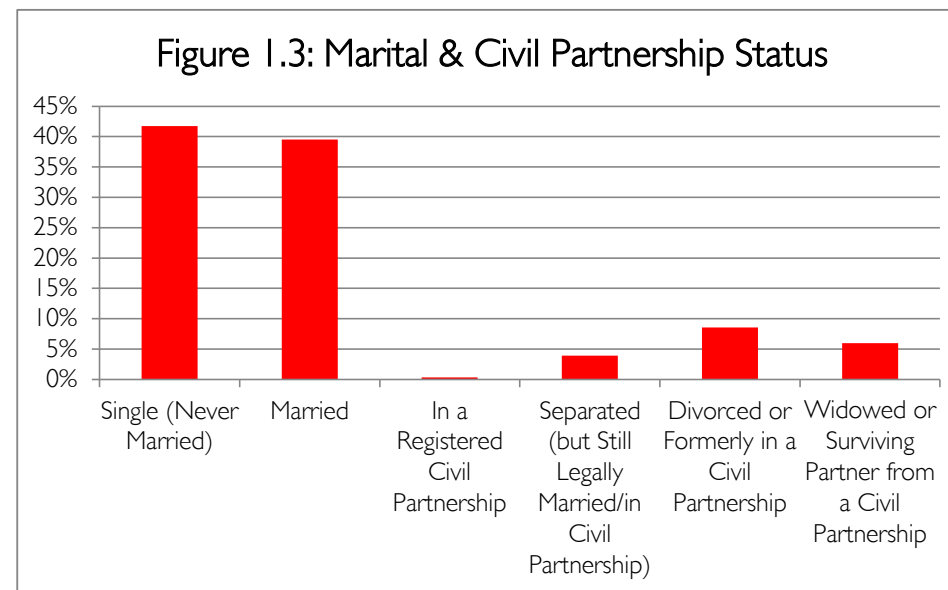

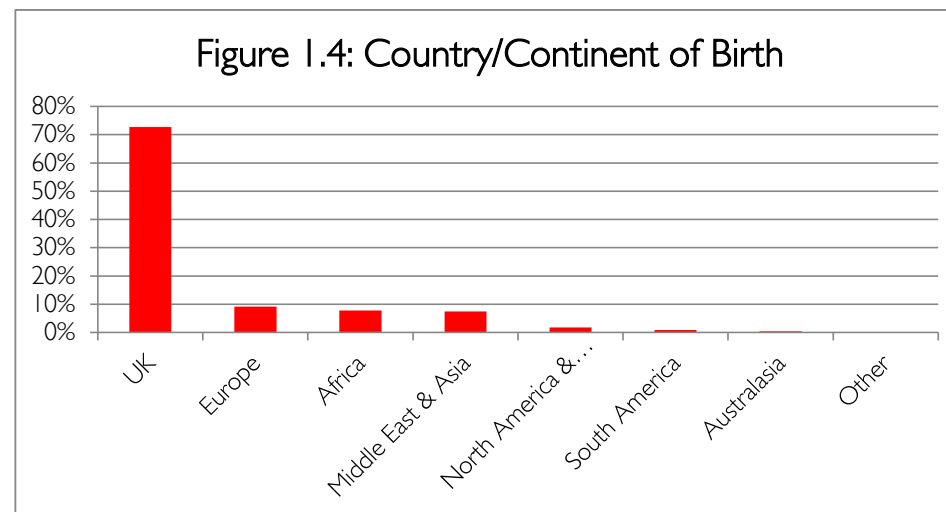

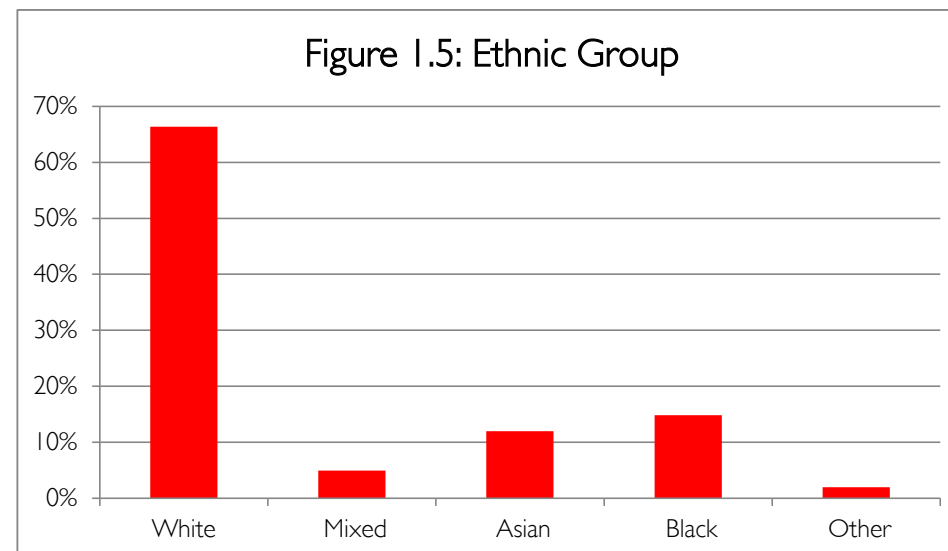

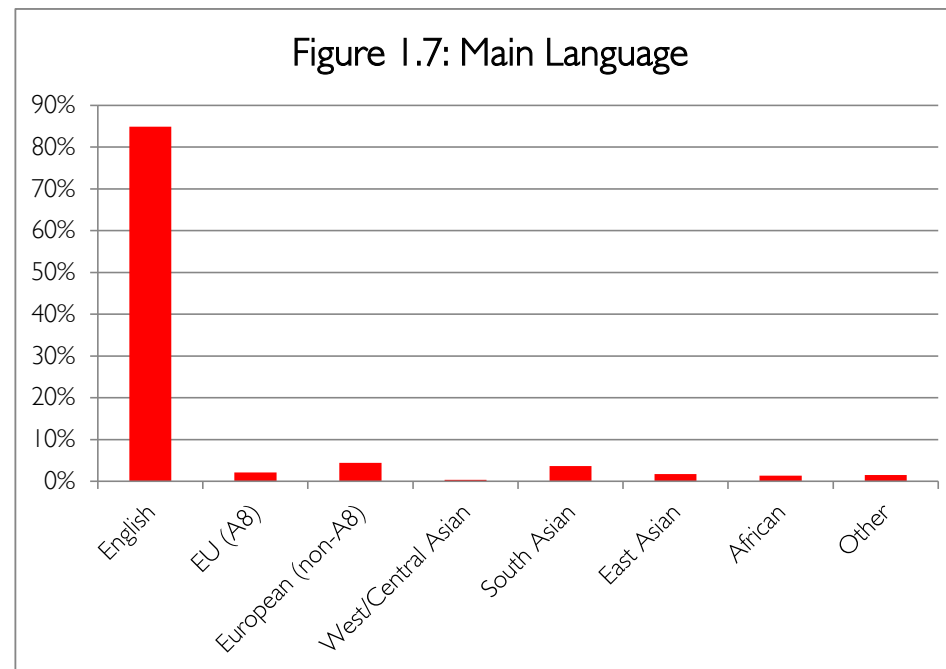

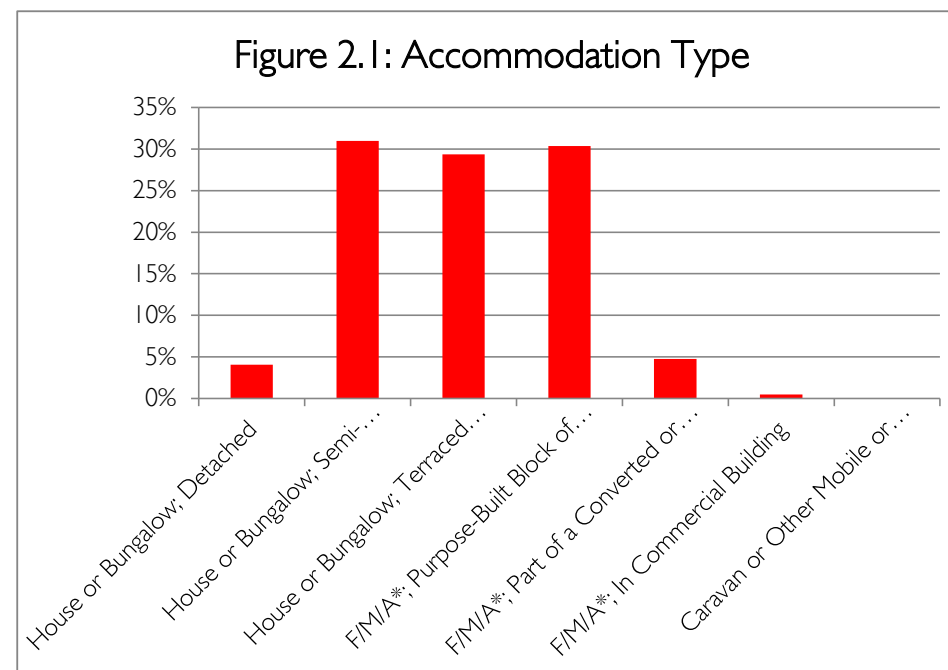

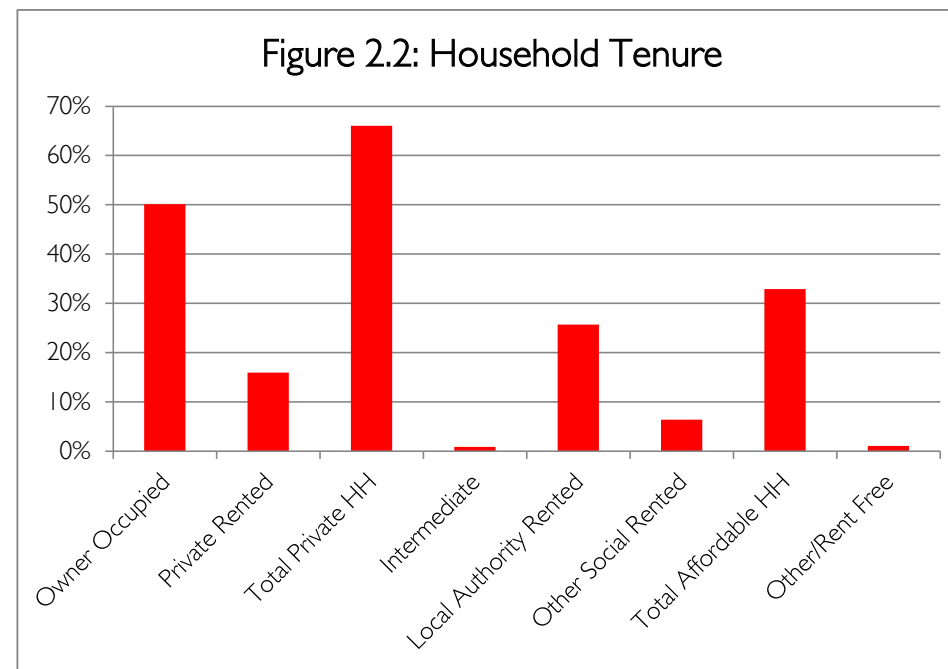

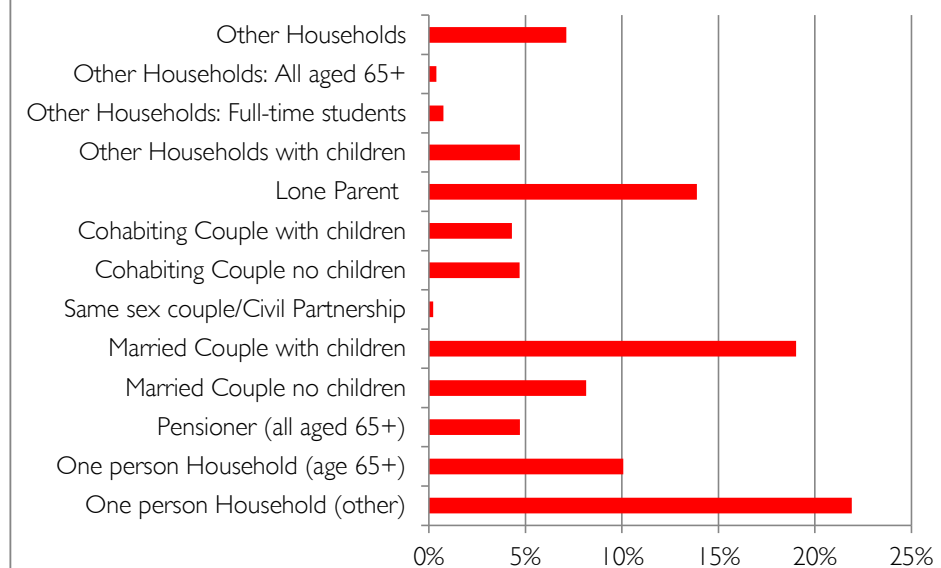

Figure 2.3: Household Composition



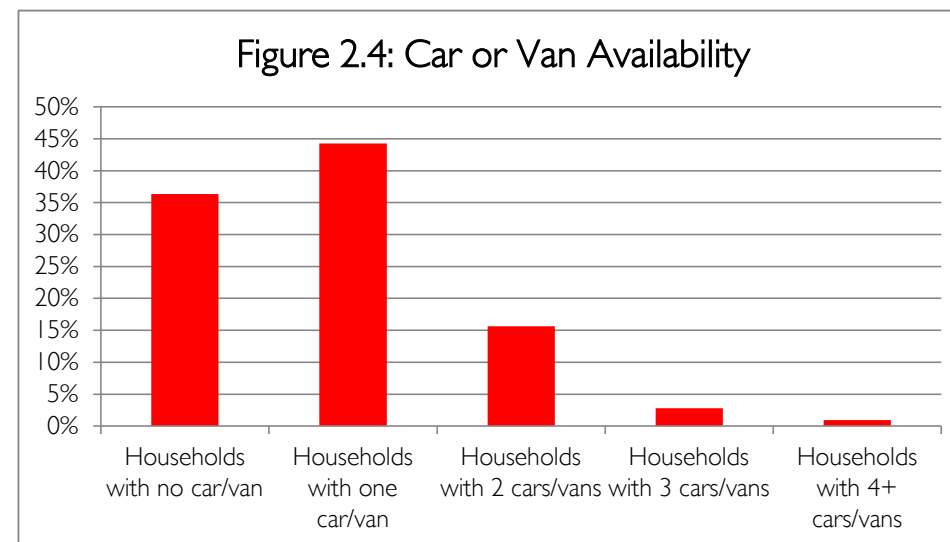

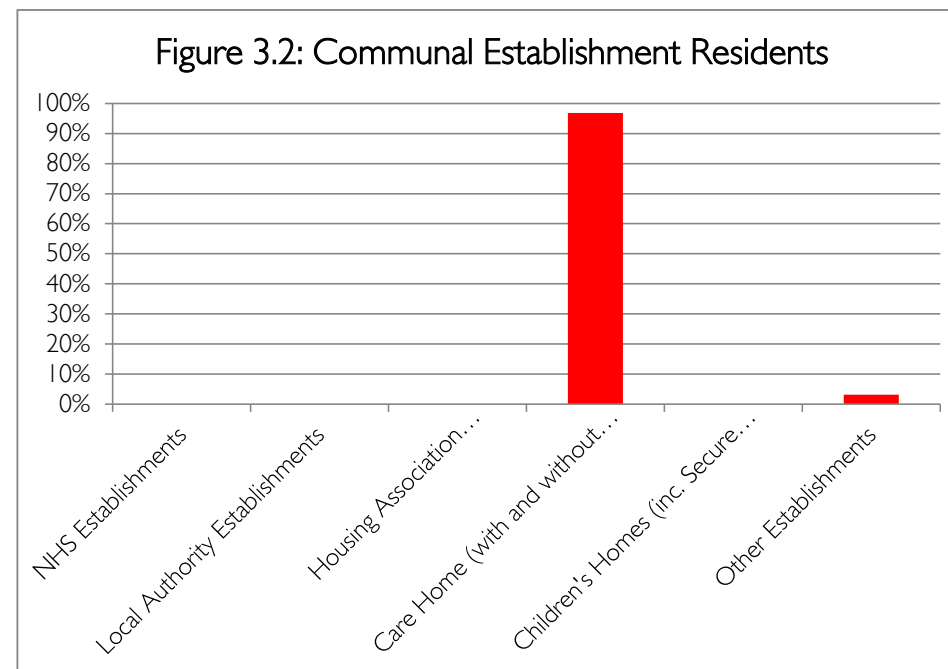

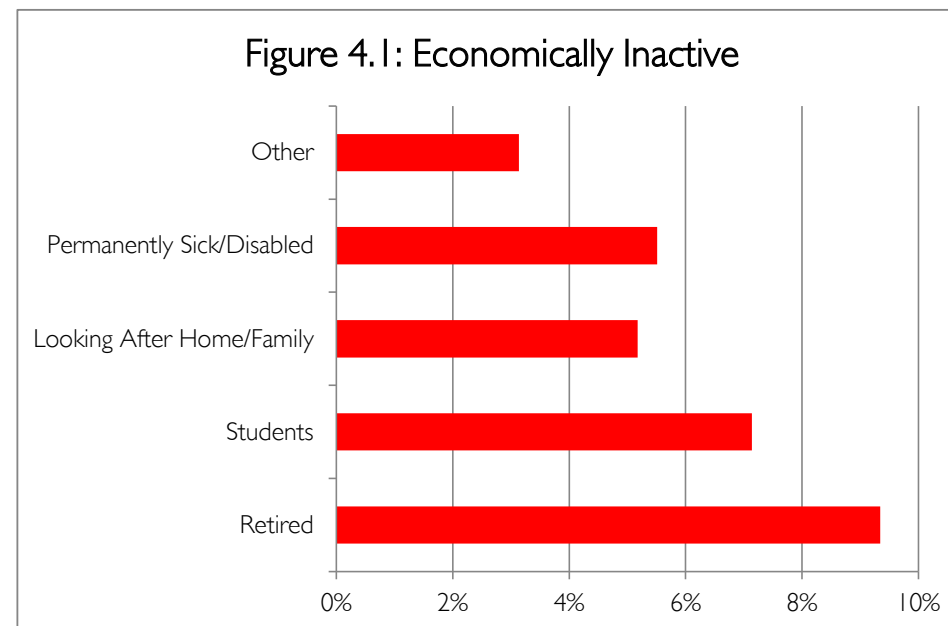

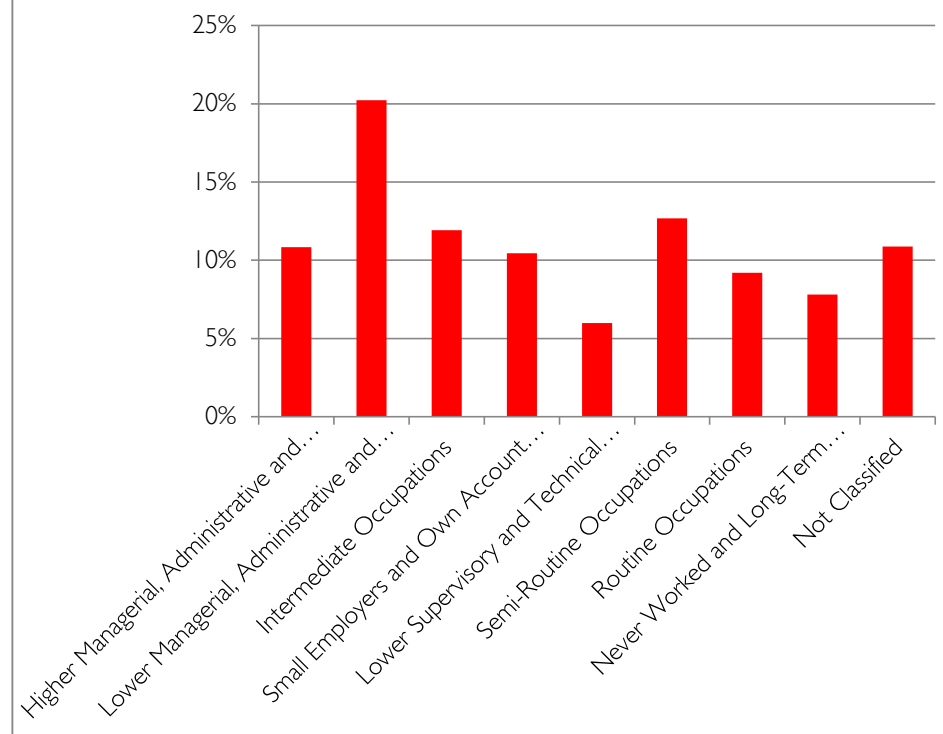

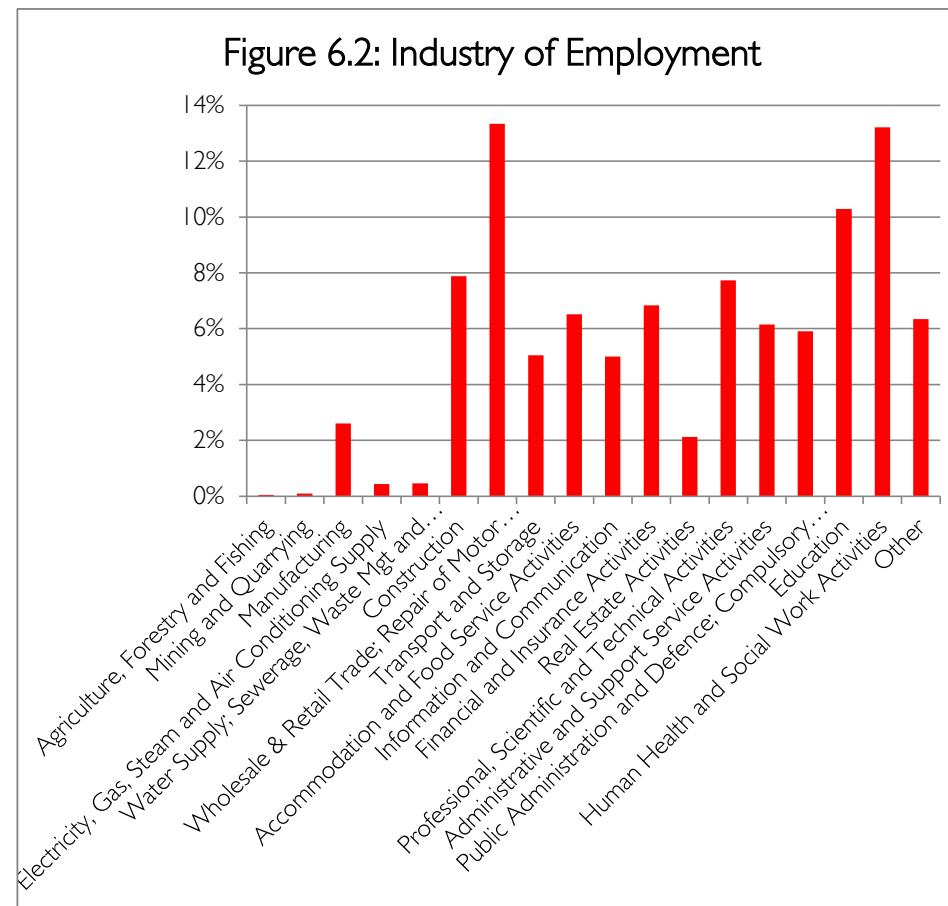
