


## BOCKING A PLACE

Please note for courses with high demand, places may be limited to 1 or 2 per setting. It may be more beneficial for you to email and book half day or full day INSET training with EYC service if you need multiple places or setting wide training. Please book course dates that are earliest in the calendar as future courses wih less than 5 attendees may be cancelled.

#### Costs & Payment

Where there is a charge for any course, this is clearly marked. "Course" includes training, briefings, bitesize webinars, forums and networks.

Invoices will be sent out ahead of the course and will need to be paid for in advance or you will not be able to attend on the day. Cancellation or non-attendance fees may apply.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

All cancellations must be **made in writing by email** at least 10 working days before any course. Any cancellations less than 10 working days will be charged at the full cost unless the place can be filled. Where a place is filled, you will only be charged an administration fee of £10 for late cancellation.

Any requests for consideration of exceptional circumstances must be made in writing with supporting evidence. These will be reviewed on a case by case basis and you will still be charged an administration fee of £10.

Where a course is advertised as free and you do not attend or cancel within 10 working days, you will be charged an administration fee of £10. If you have registered for a catch up recording of the course, you must view the recording and complete a full evaluation within 14 days of receiving the link to avert an administration charge of £10.

## EVALUATIONS

## PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID

You must **complete the online part of PFA** before you attend the in-person date. You will be sent a link in an email from eyc.training@royalgreenwich.gov.uk in advance of the inperson date. It is your responsibility to check receipt of this important email **at least 3 weeks prior to the in person date**. Please check your junk inbox before contacting us.

If you do not complete the online section, you will not be able to join the in-person day. You will not be permitted entry and will still be charged the full cost.

#### Course Outline:

This is a two part course with Day 1 online and Day 2 face to face classroom based training. You must complete the online part before attending the in person date. Full PFA certified course (minimum of 12 hours) must be renewed every 3 years to comply with the EYFS.

All providers to "consider whether paediatric first aiders need to undertake annual refresher training, during any three-year certification period to help maintain basic skills and keep up to date with any changes to PFA procedures" (Annex A: 7, EYFS)

Course Aims: This course equips participants with knowledge & skills to help a baby/child who is/has or with

- unresponsive and breathing normally/not breathing normally
- having a seizure
- choking
- bleeding
- suffering from shock caused by severe blood loss (hypovolemic shock)
- suffering from anaphylactic shock
- had an electric shock
- burns or scalds
- a suspected fracture
- head, neck or back injuries
- suspected of being poisoned
- foreign body in eyes, ears or nose
- an eye injury
- suffering from the effects of extreme heat or cold
- a diabetic emergency; an asthma attack; an allergic reaction; meningitis; and/or febrile convulsions


- Be able to assess an emergency situation and prioritise what action to take
- Understand the role and responsibilities of the paediatric first aider (including appropriate contents of a first aid box and how to record accidents and incidents)







This in person classroom based training covers recognising and responding to child abuse liked to faith or belief. This training is multi-agency and is delivered directly with GSCP.

#### Course Aims: This course provides

- knowledge and awareness of abuse arising as a result of child abuse linked to faith or belief
- when and how to report
- information about national action plan to tackle child abuse linked to faith or belief or arising from religion or superstition
- understanding of beliefs in witchcraft, spirit possession, demons or the devil, the evil eye or djinns, dakini, kindoki, ritual or muti murders
- understanding how fear of the supernatural is manipulated for trafficking for domestic slavery or child sexual exploitation.
- clarity that beliefs which are the focus of action plan are not confined to one faith, nationality or ethnic community.

The training does NOT include child abuse within culture or faith contexts eg female genital mutilation or forced marriage nor does cover child abuse in faith settings which are incidental to the abuse, eg, sexual abuse by paedophiles in a religious community.
