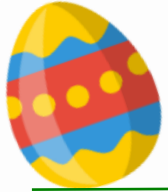




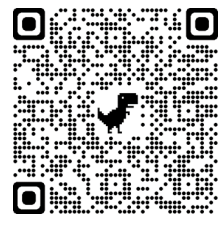

ASK-SEND consultation opportunity for parents and carers

This service involves families booking a telephone consultation. Calls are supported by an Educational Psychologist, Health Visiting SEND Specialist, and Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENCo).

Every family's journey is unique, and we're here to listen and offer guidance that suits your child.

Ask-SEND is a reflective thinking space for parents and carers of children aged 2–5 years with special educational needs and disabilities.

Families can book a telephone consultation to talk through concerns, ask questions, and explore next steps by scanning the QR code and completing the short form.
